## **What is the Writing Center?**

The Writing Center provides free tutorial services to all Mason writers. Students, faculty, staff, and alumni may make an appointment to see a tutor. Appointments are offered in 45-minute face-to-face or online sessions.

## **What should I expect?**

We work with writers at every stage of the process:

- brainstorming
- outlining
- composing
- revising
- polishing

Tutors do not act as editors but help writers improve by modeling effective writing strategies and techniques. During a typical session, tutor and writer will review the assignment, read through the writing, set goals for the session, and discuss strategies for effective writing.

## **How do I make an appointment?**

To register and make an appointment, go to the Writing Center's website: [writingcenter.gmu.edu](http://writingcenter.gmu.edu). A current or former G# will be required for registration and a GMU ID must be presented at the time of the appointment. Because walk-in appointments are never guaranteed, we encourage Mason writers to book an appointment well in advance.
