Columbia Pike is a key transportation corridor in Arlington County, connecting travelers from Annandale and Bailey's Crossroads to the Pentagon and DC Metro. Arlington and Fairfax Counties are planning a partnership to develop a street car line that will stretch along nearly five miles of the Pike to provide more efficient and affordable transportation capacity along the route. Immediately surrounding the Pike is a richly diverse population of people and small businesses that thrive in the existing community, but may not be able to remain in the area if the new transportation services promote high-end development that might drive up the cost of living and doing business.
