- Develops and conducts programs and co-curricular, educational, cultural, and social opportunities for students, faculty, and staff on LGBTQ issues.
- Provides consultation, education, technical assistance, training, and resources to faculty, staff, administration, Mason offices, and departments as well as others interested in ensuring that their services are inclusive and welcoming around LGBTQ issues.
